MARRIED

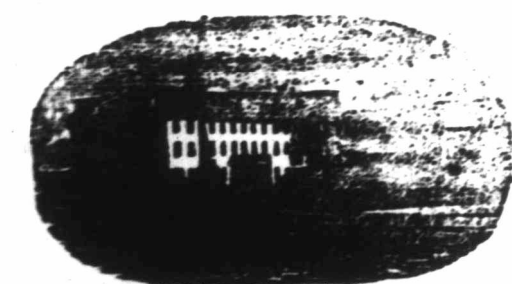

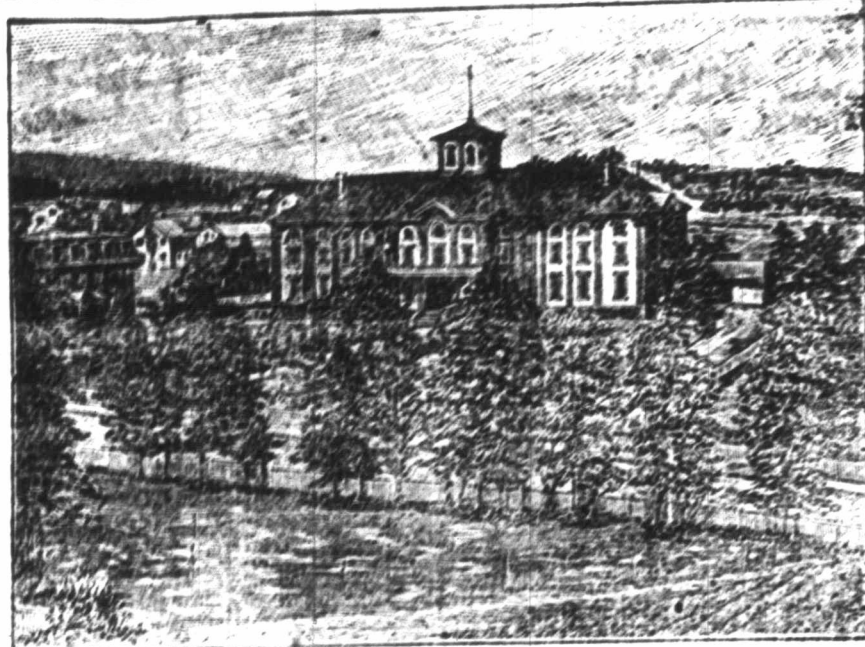
