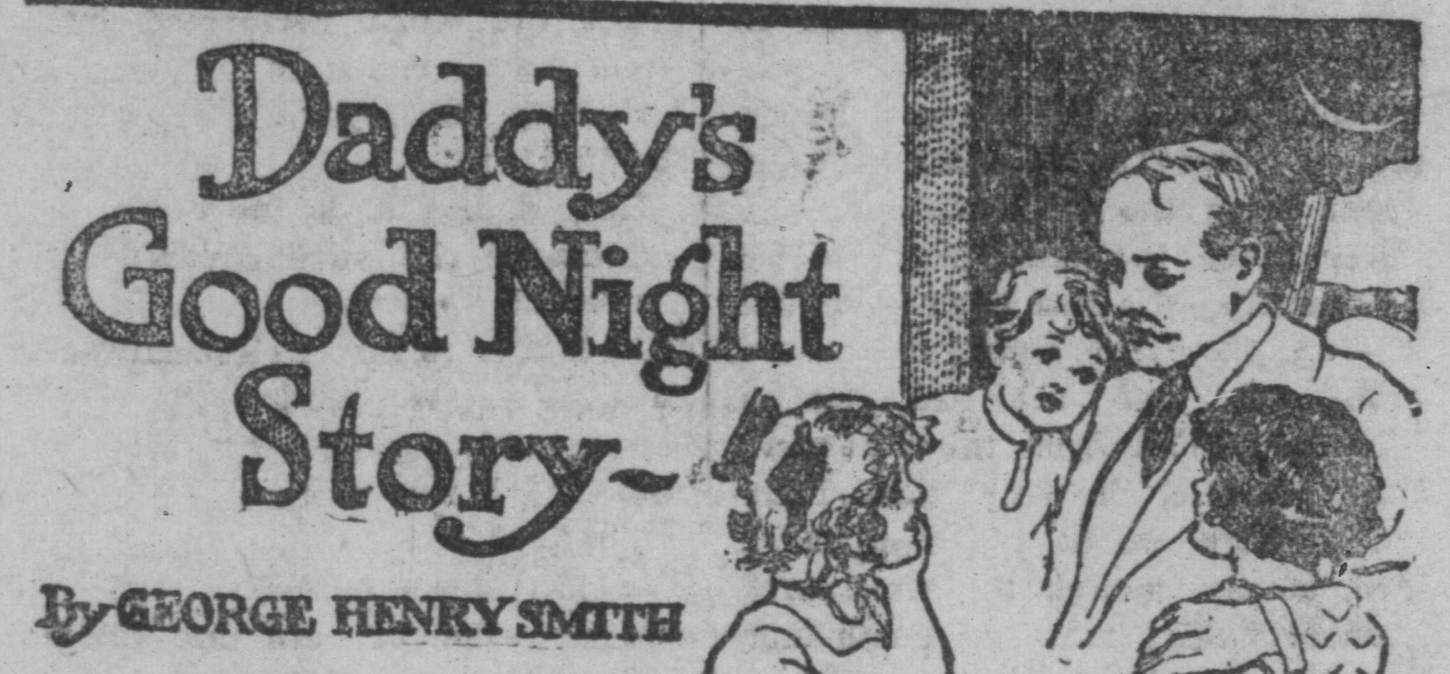
*** Sayings of Children ***
