

SELF-CANCELLING POSTAGE.--A self cancell-ing postage stamp has been invented in the United States. Instead of moistening the back of those stamps, the face being gummed is dampened and placed on the letter as usual, when such an impression is made on the face of the letter as renders their removal impos-sible. If by any process the stamps are tak en off, it must be destroyed, while the impres-sion remains plainly upon the letter. The self-cancelling operation will save a vast amount of time and labour in all post-offices, and insares security against being re-used or amount of time and labour in all post-offices, and insures security against being re used or picked off by thieves. 
