The exhibition of the county society shall be held wherever the majority of the directors, or of a quorum thereof...

Any two or more county and township societies may, by agreement between the directors thereof, or a majority of directors of each such society, unite their funds, or any portion thereof...

No separate township show shall be held in the township in which the county show shall be held in any year, but the funds of the township society in such case shall be merged with those of the county society...
