ONTARIO'S HEALTH

Second Day's Proceedings of the Provincial Board of Health.

Dr. Cassidy presided at the meetings yesterday of the Provincial Board of Health. He produced a letter from the New York City Health Commission offering to supply for the city a Hyatt filtering plant that would filter 18,000,000 gallons of water per day for the sum of \$180,000, including buildings.

The Chairman again adverted to the danger of cholera appearing in Canada and to the risks run by drinking impure water. He hoped the city would be willing to provide the funds necessary for this system of filtration, which had proved so successful in other cities and in American cities and in which he had full confidence.

Communications were read from Kierulff, Bolevay and other places giving particulars of outbreaks of diphtheria. Other letters testified to the prevalence of smallpox in the border States. In view of these unsatisfactory conditions local boards of health are to be organized in all the municipalities at their command to stamp out disease where it exists and to prevent its recurrence.
