MR. GEORGE MUNRO.

R. GEORGE MUNRO, of New York, is a distinguished Nova Scotian, and one of the most liberal patrons of Dalhousie College, In 1870 he established and endowed the Professorship of Physics in 1881 that of History and Political Economy. In 182 he founded a chair of English Language and Literature, and in 1833 added the Professorship of Constitutional and International Law. and Tutorships of Classics and Mathematics. In 1881 again he founded the Professorship of Metaphysics.

Besides these larger donations, Mr. Munro has given his name to a large number of Exhibitions and Bursaries, for the encouragement of study in different departments, and especially for the promotion of more thorough work in the High Schools and Academies of the Maritime Provinces. The sums given in this way since 1880 amount altogether to \$60,000.

The present holders of the George Munro Professor ship are Rev. Dr. Forrest, Dr. MacGregor, Mr. Seth. and Mr. MacMechan.
