MINOR DISABILITY CASES.

CANADA	For a permanent disability of less than 5 per cent of total disability a gratuity not exceeding \$100.00.
UNITED KINGDOM	For disablement less than 20 per cent of total, a gratuity not to exceed \$973.32.
NEW ZEALAND	These cases are dealt with specially.
AUSTRALIA	These cases are dealt with specially.
SOUTH AFRICA	On Imperial basis.

ALTERNATIVE PENSIONS FOR TOTAL DISABILITY CASES.

CANADA	No alternative pensions.
UNITED KINGDOM	A pension based on his pre-war earnings and present earning capacity but not to exceed \$1,265.83. The rate of such pension to be determined yearly from the Board of Trade figures of the cost of living.
NEW ZEALAND	No alternative pension but to maintain a man and his dependents in accordance with their pre-war standard of comfort, his pension may be increased by \$252.72 but total payable in respect of man not to exceed \$1,265.83.
AUSTRALIA	No alternative pensions.
SOUTH AFRICA	A pension on same principle as Royal Warrant, which would allow a maximum of \$252.72. If man is permanently bedridden, or incapable of earning—an additional \$189.80 may be granted.

Note:—The rates for Canada include a bonus for one year to take effect September 1st, 1919.
