ALTERNATIVE PENSIONS FOR TOTAL DISABILITY CASES.

No alternative pensions. CANADA

UNITED KINGDOM A pension based on his pre-war earnings and present earning capacity but not to exceed \$1,265.33. The rate of such pension to be determined yearly from the Board of Trade figures of the cost of living.

No alternative pension but to maintain a man and his dependents in NEW ZEALAND accordance with their pre-war standard of comfort, his pension may be increased by \$252.72 but total payable in respect of man not to exceed \$1,265.33.

No alternative pensions. AUSTRALIA

SOUTH AFRICA A pension on same principle as Royal Warrant, which would allow a maximum of \$252.72. If man is permanently bedridden, or incapable of earning—an additional \$189.80 may be granted.

Note:—The rates for Canada include a bonus for one year to take effect September 1st, 1919.
