Increases totalling $4\cdot 2$ million for the operation and maintenance of federal public buildings are more than offset by decreases of $4\cdot 4$ million in other expenditures of the Architectural Branch. Expenditures of the Engineering Branch are estimated at $28\cdot 9$ million for 1952-53, an increase of $3\cdot 7$ million over the total of $25\cdot 2$ million in 1951-52.

Resources and Development

Estimated expenditures of 35.6 million for the Department of Resources and Development for 1952-53 are 3.8 million greater than the total of 31.8million for 1951-52. The following table presents a comparative summary of expenditures for the last two fiscal years:

Expenditures of the Engineering and Water Resources Branch are estimated at \$17.1 million, of which \$13 million represents the Government's contribution to the provinces in connection with the Trans-Canada Highway. In 1951-52 the contribution was 12.8 million.

Royal Canadian Mounted Police
