Hehad a long distance call from Mr.Charlton in New York about the cutting off of the grant, which, Mr. Charlton said, was news to him and came as a shock. He stated to Dr.Hibbert that General White in cutting off the grant on behalf of the International Paper did so without orders from N.Y. office and acted beyond his power, and Mr.Gharlton asked Dr. Hibbert to assure Sir Arthur Currie that he would get busy at once to rectify the situation and do all in his power to see that the grant was not cut off.
