

Guelph, April 13.—(Special.)—Medical Health Officer Robinson has received the result of the special analysis of specimens of Guelph water sub-mitted to Dr. Amyot, provincial specialist. Eight of the specimens were collected from various wells around the city, while the ninth was the sample from city waterworks. It was found that the city water was much superior to the well water, even at its best, and out of the eight wells examined only one was found free fre chemical matter.
