17. Candidates for call to the Bar must give notice, signed by a Bencher, during the preceding Term.
18. Candidates for call or certificate of fitness are required to file with the secretary their papers and pay their fees on or before the third Saturday before Term. Any candidate tailing to do so will be required to put in a special petition, and pay an additional fee of 82 .
