by fickness, lameness, blindness, age or infirmity whatfoever, he shall be entitled to, and receive from the fund of the Society, Twenty Shillings weekly, during the first twelve weeks of his inability aforefaid, and Ten Shillings weekly during the remainder of fuch inability.

Funeral ex-ART. 5. On the death of every Member, pences and to having contributed as aforefaid, and while Widows & the income shall exceed the expenditure, Children. there shall be paid out of the Funds, to the person intitled to the receive the same, Ten Pounds for the expence of his Funeral, and Fifty Pounds for the use of his Widow and Children, or fuch other of his family as may have depended folely upon him for fubfiftence. Ten Pounds, shall, in like manner, be paid to every Member, having contributed as aforefaid, on the death of his Wife, to defray the expences of her Funeral.

ART. 6. Every person in sound health, Who may become between twenty one and forty five years of Menibers. age, refiding within the Province of Lower Canada, may become a Member, on being balloted
