

# Porcupine Active Work Thruout Camp

## Mining Market Inclined to Drag Public Trading is Apathetic

Decidedly Uninteresting Movements in Week-end Session—Prices Barely Change—Cobalts Quiet.

World Office, Saturday Evening, Feb. 17.  
Porcupine stocks moved along in a decidedly apathetic manner in the mining exchanges during today's session, and coincident with the dull trading under way. It was quite apparent that the majority of the list was inclined to drag toward lower prices whenever selling of any consequence put in an appearance. The whole trend of the market partook of a somewhat weaker nature, and net changes for the day in nearly every instance ran into declines.

From the very outset of the dealings it was apparent that the mining stocks were in for a decidedly quiet day. The public speculative movement dwindled away still further as the session progressed, and the total sales consequently fell far below their usual level. Prices moved along in a lethargic way, and the distinct feeling of apathy under way was clearly demonstrated in the fact that V'pdon, usually one of the active spots in the list, did not vary even the minutest fraction on the Standard Exchange throughout the day.

Small Declines Shown.  
It was only to be expected that dullness of this nature would, if it had any effect whatever, work out against the interest of holders, and this was exactly what happened. Small declines in quotations were the general rule, but these were generally so insignificant in volume that they were ignored by traders, who, it is to be said, they served to effectually show that the underlying trend was liable to prove disappointing at any moment.

Dome Extension showed about the most extensive price movement for the day, the range between the high and low quotations on that issue amounting to nearly two points. The shares in the early dealings sold at 41, but dropped back to 39.12 under bear pressure, closing on a rally at 40.4 bid. Elsewhere in the cheaper Porcupines the movement was so restricted in scope as to call for no comment. Hollinger dropped five points at 12.29, and closed on offer there, with bids five points removed.

The Cobalts were quiet and in the main featureless. The dividend paying issues were in fair demand, and generally showed a firm undertone. Crown Reserve maintained its recent advance to \$2, but Nipissing, on the other hand, was under selling pressure, and recorded a decline, selling off to \$7.40, and closing on offer there.

### Porcupine Fires CAUSE BIG LOSS

Porcupine, Feb. 15.—(From Our Man Up North).—Apparently Golden City is being wiped out by a process of gradual reduction, the third night having occurred in the town since Jan. 4. Last night the Pribes building was totally destroyed, while the Welch block was partially wiped out. South Porcupine, more fortunate, has suffered from but one big fire, when the Liberty Stores and Hughie Mulhern's Cafe were destroyed Wednesday night. The total losses from fires this week in the camp are figured at \$50,000. Light board buildings heated with kerosene make it easy for the flames to get under headway before detection.
