

amount of arrears will reach the large sum of at least \$200.00. The balance in favour of the Congregation is \$55.54, so that if the whole amount promised had been received we could have shown a balance in favour of the Congregation amounting to \$255.54.

Estimated Amount needed for 1885.

The following items will show, approximately, the amount we need to raise in 1885:—

" Caretaker and Leader of Choir.....	250 00
" Miscellaneous expenses.....	300 00
To meet cost of Double Windows, say ...	375 00
" Wipe off the Chairman's Note	500 00
Total.....	\$5,249 68

We believe the raising of this amount is within the power of the Congregation, inasmuch as our total receipts from all sources during 1884 reached the sum of \$5,572.08. With confidence in God's blessing, promised to all who seek to do work in His name and for His glory, we may, therefore, with cheerful hearts and willing feet, fearlessly because in faith, tread the path of 1885, "looking unto Jesus, the Author and Finisher of our faith."
