

PRESBYTERIAN APPEAL FOR SPECIAL OFFERING
TORONTO, Dec. 22.—In order to meet a budget of \$1,600,000 for 1920, an increase of about 25 per cent over last year's budget, the general board of the Presbyterian Church in Canada has issued an appeal to Presbyterians throughout the Dominion for a special Christmas offering. It will be necessary to raise \$500,000 in December and January, over \$200,000 more than in the corresponding period last year. Receipts on budget for the eleven months ended November 30, totalled \$700,477, an advance of 12 per cent, whereas expenditures for the same period amounted to \$1,362,885, an increase of about 25 per cent.

TO CHECK STUNTING IN CIVILIAN FLYING
OTTAWA, Dec. 22.—(Canadian Press).—Stunting in civilian flying is being checked by an amendment to the air regulations, 1920. The superintendent of the certificate branch of the air board in a report stated that accidents had occurred in the course of civilian flying due to machines being stunted with passengers, with or without their special request. There is no purpose in stunting in civil flying," says the report, "and its prohibition would be beneficial, not only for the purpose of preventing accidents, but also for the purpose of inducing a realization that flying does not involve or require the stunting of risks."

SOLDIERS TAKE CITY HALL AND BAR EMPLOYEES
Military Forces Also Occupy Municipal Buildings of Dublin.
PARLEYS CONTINUE
Only Hitch in Peace Discussions—Will Be Resumed Soon.

DUBLIN, Dec. 22.—Military forces today occupied the city hall and municipal buildings in accordance with the demand on Monday by General Boyd, commander of the Dublin district, who sent a notice to the Dublin corporation requesting possession of the buildings by today. A large portion of the public services will be discontinued, as no other office has been secured. Sentries were posted and the erection of defences carried out early this morning. When the city officials arrived only the town clerk, his assistant and two employees in his department were allowed to enter.

WAS ONLY HITCH.
DUBLIN, Dec. 22.—There is no truth in the rumors that peace negotiations have been broken off, the Associated Press is authoritatively informed. There has been only a hitch in the peace discussions, and the belief is expressed that the negotiations will soon be resumed, with good prospects of success.

DUBLIN PRESS DOES NOT EXPECT MEASURE TO GO INTO EFFECT.
Dublin, Dec. 22.—Passage of the Irish home rule bill by the British Parliament is not viewed as specially important by newspapers here. It is recognized the bill will not be accepted by either Ulster or the rest of Ireland, and that the British Government may never decide to use its provisions into operation.

WOULDN'T TRY TO ARREST VALERA.
LONDON, Dec. 22.—The Central News, in a dispatch from Dublin, says that should Eamon de Valera, "president of the Irish Republic," be arrested, no attempt will be made to arrest him. This statement is attributed to officials in Dublin.

LABOR TAKES TWO SEATS FROM GOVT.
LONDON, Dec. 22.—(Canadian Associated Press).—In the by-election in the constituency of Epsom, Surrey, England, the Labour party has won two seats from the Conservative government.
