These locatees agreed to allow the timber on their respective locations to be included in the general sale of timber on the Reserve to the McGibbon Lbr.Co.subject to the following conditions:-

Robert Stock, Paddy Stock and Emma Lafleche agreed to accept payment of bonus at the sale price of \$5.50 / per M.f.b.m. based on the estimated quantity of timber on their respective locations:

Robert Stock....100.000 f.b.m.....\$550.00 PAID Paddy Stock.....120.000 "\$660.00 PAID Emma Lafleche....90.000 "\$495.00 PAID.

The following locatees decided to await the final cutting of their timber, and then be paid at the rate of \$5.50 per M.f.b.m. based on the scale returns of the timber actually out:-
