CENTRAL CANADA AND NAVY LEAGUE

(Port Arthur News-Chronicle)

Port Arthur is honored this year by being selected by the Dominion Council of the Navy League of Canada as the city in which to hold its annual council meeting.

We welcome the men and women who have been elected to fill a position of great responsibility; for the Navy League of Canada stands for the greatest service that has been given the British people, and which, under the provision of God, has done more than any other agency in establishing British rule and civilization around the globe.

The group of islands on the coast of North Western Europe, known as the British Isles, were the scene for centuries of various battles between peoples of various races, ambitious to hold these western islands and establish a kingdom thereon. Ancient Britain warred with Rome, Rome withdrew and Saxons came. Norwegians, Swedes, Danes, Jutes, all in rapid succession ravaged the coasts, settled on the banks of the great rivers and sought for more land.

Slowly furnished statesmen led the people—King Offa in the eighth century said—"He who would be secure on land must be supreme at sea." King Alfred built a fleet which was the means of securing his successor the unity of England. King Harold lost his kingdom because he had no navy to meet the Duke of Normandy on the channel.

No invasion has taken place in England since that far off date, 1066, but again and again invasion has been threatened and great armadas and fleets have been built to subdue the British people and put the islands of Britain under the rule of a foreign power, but the British Navy has always been equal to the emergency.

A new danger, however, now presents itself. Britain is no longer confined to the "bright little, tight little islands" of Northwestern Europe, but is scattered around the earth. The island of Australia, the Dominion of New Zealand, the great Commonwealth of India, the vast continent of Africa, the commonwealth of South Africa, and last, but by no means the least, the far flung Dominion of Canada, whose coasts are washed by the waters of three great oceans and whose inland waterways are the natural routes of trade and commerce for the world, taking the products of a continent, by water, to every port of the world, and

bringing into the heart of a continent the goods of other lands.

More than ever before in history the existence of Britain depends on its sea power. The motherland has been more than generous. Her fleets have won her the greatest empire the world has ever known. Her people in these countries free constitutions of self-government, and protectors of their rights.

When the Canadian Government asks the Mother Country to abrogate its right to sign an agreement with the United States of America, and allow the Canadian representative to be sole signatory for Canada, then the Government of Canada should seriously face the logical issue its own act involves, and ask itself if it has the necessary sea power to see that its fishery agreement with the United States of America can be enforced by Canada without the assistance of the sea power of the Motherland.

If the people of Canada were alive to the issue they would enforce the fisheries treaty with the United States of America.
