C. OF ENGLAND DIOCESES.

Changes in conection with the administration of the Church of England in Eastern Canada are being discussed and it is thought that all the dioceses of Ontario will form a provincial synod to be presided over by Archbishop Hamilton of Ottawa. Bishop Farthing will be in charge of the diocese of Montreal, Bishop Dunn at Quebec and Bishop Richardson at Fredericton. Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island will be under the charge of Bishop Worrell. This will make practically five dioceses with only four bishops. It is also hoped that Newfoundland will enter the new ecclesiastical province.
