

INDIANS CLAIM RENT IN CORN FOR 150 YEARS USE OF ISLAND

Brantford, Ont., March 23—Efforts to collect 900 bushels of Indian corn, being the rent for 150 years of Pelee Island, at the rate of six bushels a year, are to be made by the Caldwell Indians, R. H. Abraham, agricultural expert of the Indian Bureau, was advised recently.

Mr. Abraham, who has just returned from Chatham, said the Indians claimed to have leased the island in 1760 or thereabout, for 999 years to an Indian agent named McKee. Mr. Abraham added that at a meeting of the tribe the Indians had elected a chief and two councillors as the first step in negotiations with the Canadian Government for the establishment of a reserve. He suggested that Walpole Island, Lake St. Clair, would be suitable, there being about 10,000 acres of arable land there.






TELLS COURT HE'S CAVE MAN


