DECLARATION

The Court declare that No. ~~8~~ 80248 Pte. Gagne, J. (C. Prov C.)

illegally absented himself without leave from No. 1 Transit Camp at Windsor, N.S. at 1313 hrs on the 10th day of September, 1943, that he is still so absent, and that on the 12th September, 1943 he was deficient, and that he is still deficient of the following articles:—
