And now, brethren, we come to you in the name of the Lord Jesus. "We beseech you, by the mercies of God, that ye whose servants we are. present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service." By your sympathy and prayers you can make our ministry among you much more effectual. Forget not the assembling of yourselves together. Let your place be always filled in the house of And forget not that other place of worship, where man talks with God as friend with friend; where faltering faith has so often been quickened into a new and higher life; where thoughts have been conceived and hopes inspired that have kindled anew the torch of Christianity and sent it forth with renewed power upon its life-giving mission; "Enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly."
