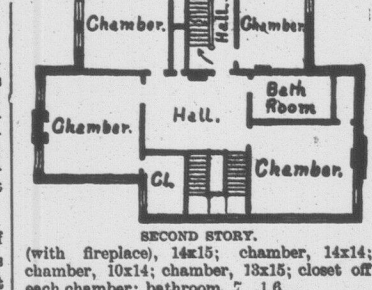

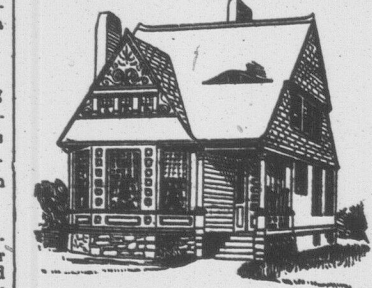
Plan and View of a Handsome Two Story Brick House
