Report submitted, and spoken to by Revs. J. C. Hurd, G. M. W. Carey, and B. F. Ratray.

Report adopted, and ordered to be printed in the Minutes of this Association. [See Report annexed.]

Moved by Rev. Thomas Todd, and seconded by Rev. J. Rowe—That we adopt the following plan for raising three thousand four hundred dollars, now needed to meet the pressing demands on the Education Society, for paying off the debts in full due on the Seminary at Fredericton, with some other matters.

That we raise in the County of York the sum of \$750.

Whereas such monies were there for paying off the debt due on the Seminary; Resolved, That the said monies be drawn, and paid over to the persons to whom such monies are due, and that the President and Secretary of the Society be a Committee to attend to the same.
