

LA VIE CATHOLIQUE

DES GUERISONS MIRACULEUSES A STE-ANNE

New York, 23.—Mgr Waring, curé de l'église de Ste-Anne, sur la 12e rue, Est, àew-York, où une neuaine, commencée le 17 juillet courant, doit se terminer le 26, rapporte que quatre guérisons miraculeuses, attribuées au bâton d'une relique de sainte Anne, ont eu lieu depuis la dernière neuaine en janvier dernier. Le premier cas, rapporte-t-il, fut celui d'un homme atteint d'une maladie de cœur qui avait résisté au traitement des spécialistes, tant aux Etats-Unis qu'à l'étranger; le second fut celui d'un aveugle privé de la vue depuis 20 ans, et que sa soeur, une infirmière diplômée, aimait à la neuaine de janvier dernier. Elle écrit qu'il y voit assez pour lire à présent. Le 3e cas est celui d'une fillette de 12 ans, blessée dans un accident d'automobile, et à qui les médecins avaient dit qu'il lui faudrait se faire amputer une jambe. Sa mère l'emmena à la neuaine sur des bénêquilles, mais depuis les bénêquilles ont été retournées à l'église. Enfin le 4e cas est celui d'une femme souffrant d'une inguérissable blessure chirurgicale, et pour qui la neuaine fut le commencement de la guérison.

On s'attend à ce que pas moins de 5,000 personnes viennent à l'église Ste-Anne durant la neuaine actuelle. Ce temple est en effet très populaire parmi les catholiques du Lower Side de New York.

Mgr CASSULO EST ARRIVE A OTTAWA

LA SITUATION EN IRLANDE

Dublin, 23.—Malgré les lettres de menaces adressées aux membres du gouvernement et députés principaux, à Dublin, l'Etat libre prend les mesures requises par la grave situation issue de meurtre récent de Kevin O'Higgins, vice-président du conseil exécutif. Le président Cosgrave a présenté en effet mercredi trois projets de loi pour oblier la garde de l'Etat tel que constitué actuellement.

Le plus important de ces projets, tu une première fois sans discussion ni explications par M. Cosgrave, accroît la portée de la loi de sécurité publique. Ce n'est pas le texte du projet, mais tout porte à croire qu'il prévoit l'abolition des procès par devant jury lorsque l'accusation a trait à l'assassinat de personnalités officielles, ou à la provocation des élections.

Ce dispositif du projet de loi est jugé essentiel, attendu que des Jurés irlandais ne condamnent jamais que sur les preuves les plus directes. Pour les cas sous-trait au jury on créera probablement de tribunaux spéciaux composés de magistrats de la Haute Cour et d'officiers de l'armée.

Les deux autres projets Je loi ont trait au problème posé par le refus des députés républicains de prendre leurs sièges au Dail et de ne pas le servir d'allégiance. Un arrêt de l'un de ces deux projets, tout député ayant de poser sa candidature, devrait s'engager

s'il est élu, à observer la constitution. Ce projet fixe également un délai passé, lequel un député ne pourra plus occuper son siège au Dail.
