GRAND ORANGE LODGE MEETS IN CHATHAM.

Gathering of More Than One Hundred at Opening Session.

ALL REPORTS GOOD.

Grand Secretary's Extensive Review of the Past Year--Treasurer Submits a Satisfactory Statement of the Finances--A Welcome by Chatham True Blue Lodge.

Chatham, N. B., March 10 (Special).--The Grand Orange Lodge of New Brunswick opened its 90th annual session at 8 o'clock this evening. R. W. Grand Master A. D. Thomas presiding. All the rest of the grand officers were in their seats and more than 100 representatives from all parts of the province were present.

Grand Master's Address.

The grand master in his address dealt with the great prosperity of the order in the province and the great gains made in the membership. He also feelingly referred to the great loss of the order met with last year in the death of William Johnson, of Bathurst, Ireland.

The grand secretary, Neil J. Morrison, submitted a lengthy report of the work of his office during the past year.

After extending to all a welcome to the grand lodge, Grand Secretary Morrison referred to this being the 90th annual session of the Grand Lodge of New Brunswick. Sixty years was a long period in the history of an organization, and organizations, like individuals, had their days of prosperity and days of adversity. There had been many changes in the personnel of the grand lodge in the 60 years, and those who had filled the positions of trust in the past had left an unequalled record of what devotion to principle can accomplish in laying a secure foundation for the future. He believed that the great principles of the order now so entrusted to mind and heart were still as true, even keeping in view that the great principles of the universe are on the side of right and therefore right will prevail.

He spoke of the devotion of the brethren of Chatham to the order and the progress made during last year.

Taking up matters of interest to the order during the past year, Grand Secretary Morrison referred to the coronation of King Edward and said that in the monarch's illness "God save the King" was the prayer of all, especially of the members of the Orange Association.

The Work of the Year Reviewed.

Reviewing the work of the order during the past year, he said nine new primary lodges were organized: Spruce No. 10, at Colville, Kings county; Elm Tree No. 18, at Moncton, Northumberland county; Riverside No. 117, at Wilson's Beach, Charlotte county; Alexandra No. 121, at Bloomfield, Charlotte county; Coronation No. 121, at Lorneville, St. John county (west); Quoddy No. 122, at Cumming Cove, Charlotte county; Empire No. 123, at Newville, Charlotte county; Dorchester No. 126, at Dorchester, Westmorland county; and Admiral Nelson No. 124, at Sussex, Kings county.

Spruce lodge was organized May 30 by James A. Moore, county master; Fred M. Spruce and the grand secretary with a large delegation from Chatham and Moncton lodges. It has now 44 members.

Elm Tree was organized July 2 by County Master R. M. Grindley, Henry Wyse, jr., D. G. Master and others, and returns 31 members.

Riverside lodge was organized July 4 by W. S. A. Douglas, P. C. M. of Charlotte and others, had a charter list of the lodge, and the members were welcomed by Rev. M. J. Foster, rector of the parish.

Alexandra lodge was organized July 22

by J. A. Lindsay, D. G. M., and County Master James Robert and others; returns 31 members.

Coronation lodge was organized August 6 by the grand secretary and Messrs. G. A. Blair, James Robinson and others; has started to build a hall; returns 32 members.

Quoddy lodge was organized September 16 by County Master J. H. McManis, W. S. A. Douglas, P. C. M., and others; has doubled its membership since organization and now returns 33 members.

Empire lodge was organized December 17 by Henry Wyse, jr., D. G. M., and others; has added largely to membership since organization and promises a bright future.

Dorchester lodge was organized January 22, by J. W. Clark, grand director of ceremonies; P. E. Heine, grand treasurer, assisted by H. G. Wadman and others, from Moncton; reports 27 members.

Admiral Nelson lodge was organized March 6, by County Master F. M. Spruce, assisted by the P. C. M., A. J. Armstrong, Grand Treasurer P. E. Heine, County Secretary James A. Moore and the grand secretary; charter list 66; judging from the enthusiasm of the members success is made sure in the interests of the association.

Three Incorporations.

Three primary lodges were incorporated during the year: Spruce No. 10, Colville, N. B., incorporated May 14; True Blue No. 90, Chatham, July 23; New Century No. 107, Moncton, October 16.

Returns for the past year were received as follows: Albert county, six primary and two to hear from; Carleton county, eight primary; Charlotte county, five primary and one to hear from; Kings (east), four primary; Kings (west), seven primary; Northumberland, five; Queens (east), seven; Queens (west), seven; Sunbury, four primary and one to hear from; Westmorland, four; St. John, 12 primary and one district lodge; St. John county (west), five primary and one to hear from; York (west), two; Westmorland, 11; York, seven primary and three to hear from; York (west), five.

Returns had been received from the following lodges: Harcourt, Reform No. 33; Wadman, L. O. L. No. 43; McArthur, No. 115, Kent county; New Brandon No. 94 and Fowler No. 123, Gloucester county. These make the total number of lodges reported to date 111 with 12 to hear from.

Membership Gain of 603.

A number of the primary lodges delayed sending in their reports until within a very short period of the holding of the session, and a number of complaints had reached the secretary from these lodges, saying that the county master had not sent them their blank returns until late in January with the result that the secretary had to send a letter direct to other lodges which were not supplied by their county masters. There was no excuse for this, for the county masters had received sufficient blanks for their several jurisdictions.

From the returns received, the past year had been one of the most successful in the history of the province. There had been many initiations and reinstatements. The statistics showed: Initiated, 522; re-initiated, 82; joined by certificate, 122; withdrawn by certificate, 96; died, 47, making a total gain for the year of 603 members.

The new system of issuing warrants had done much to place the order on a proper basis. Every lodge received a finished class set of books, gavel, seal and ritual.

Visitations.

During the year the secretary was present at the organization of three new primary lodges. He visited King Edward lodge, at Penzance, Charlotte county, and on the invitation of the county master of Queens (east) county lodge, he was present at the annual meeting of that lodge. He was accompanied by John Kenney, P. C. M., of St. John. Seven companions were proposed and initiated into the sublime degree of Royal Sovereign. Acknowledgment of the courtesy of Isaac T. Hetherington and the members was made.

In company with Scott E. Morrill, county master of St. John, Hon. A. McKinnon and others, the secretary visited Inverville, L. O. L. No. 16, St. John county. They drove 35 miles in a blinding snow storm to keep the lodge in good working order, and well versed in the secret work of the order. Three were advanced to the Royal Arch, Purple Degree. He also visited the lodge of the lodge in St. John county west, Kings county, and all the lodges in St. John county except L. O. L. No. 6.

Deaths.

During the year 47 members died. Prominent in the list were three past grand officers of the grand lodge: James Kelly, P. C. M., Rev. G. C. Moore, P. G. chaplain, and C. W. Hopkins, past deputy grand secretary.

The sale of supplies in the jurisdiction for the year was a record breaker. The receipts from this source have nearly trebled other years and gave one of many reports that the order is in the ascendancy in New Brunswick.

General Matters.

In regard to propagation work the secretary said the money set aside by the grand lodge at its last session, though not as large a sum as some would desire, had helped very materially in the work accomplished during the year. It was hoped that the grand lodge may see the wisdom of renewing the same arrangement as was in force last year by making a grant to this amount to the secretary.

The anniversary of the 12th of July was generally celebrated and the day had lost none of its old time enthusiasm in this jurisdiction.

The claims of the official organ, the Sentinel newspaper of Toronto, were brought to the notice of the grand lodge, and a better patronage asked for it.

In regard to correspondence the secretary said it had been very large during the year and dealt principally with the internal working of the association. In this connection he had received a notice of appeal against a decision rendered by Westmorland county lodge, which papers will be placed before the proper committee, and an appeal from L. O. L. No. 33, asking to be transferred from Kings east to Kings west county lodge.

In conclusion the secretary congratulated the lodge on its great prosperity during the year. The order had been greatly strengthened by the addition of nine new lodges and many members added to the old lodges. The hope was expressed that the gain would be equally great this year.

The treasurer, P. E. Heine, in his report showed the past year to be the most successful financial year in the order's history.

Chatham, N. B., March 11--(Special).--The Grand Orange Lodge of New Brunswick resumed business at 10 o'clock this morning. The morning session was taken up with the receiving of reports of the county masters.
