WHEREAS We have given Authority and Direction to Our Governor or Lieutenant Governor or person administed fing the Government of Our Province of Lower-Canada for the time being, to fum. mon'a fufficient number of discreet and proper persons to the Legislative Council there. of and alfo, to fummon and call together an Affembly in and for the faid Province; And Our Lieutenant Governor, in the ablence of Our Governor of the laid Province. by and with the advice of Our Executive Council, hath resolved to meet Our said Legiffative Council and Affembly. KNOW YE therefore, that We do for that end publish this Our Royal Proclamation, and do hereby declare that Our Lieutenant Governor of Our faid Province hath this day given order to iffue out Writs in due form for calling together the Legislative Council and Assembly of Our said Province, which Write are to bear Test on the Twenty-sourth day of May Instant, and to be returnable on the "Tenth day of July following. IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our faid Province to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS Our Trufty and Well beloved ALURED CLARKE, Esquire, Our Lieutenant Governor and Commander in Chief of Our Province of Lower-Canada, and Major General Commanding Our forces in North America, at Our Castle of St. Lews in Our City of Quebec, this Fourteenth Day of May, in the Year of Our LORD On thousand seven hundred and ninety-two, and in the Thirty-second Year of Our Reign
