XX.

Quidquid in Compoſitione Pacis, inter Sacram Regiam Majeſtatem *Hispania*, & Sacram Regiam Majeſtatem *Luſitania*, proximè ineunda, contentum fuerit, præviâ Sacra Regia Majeſtatis *Magna Britannia* Approbatione, huius Tractatûs pars eſſentialis eſſe cenſebitur, perinde atque hic transcriptum eſſet ad verbum. S. inſuper Regia Majeſtas *Magna Britannia* ſeſe offert Sponſorem, ſive Guaranterem fore prædictæ Pacis Compoſitionis, quod illa reâpſe, conceptiſque verbis præſtare ſpondet, eum in finem ut inviolatius, ſanctiusque ſervetur.

XXI.

Tractatus Pacis hodiè initus inter S. Regiam Majeſtatem Catholicam, & Regiam ſuam Celſitudinem *Sabaudia* Ducem, in hoc Tractatu ſpeciali èr, tanquam pars ejus eſſentialis, incluſus eſt &

and on the other, ſhall be granted to the ſaid Subjects of each of their ſaid Royal Majeſties, in order to their ſelling the aforeſaid things, or any other their Effects, or carrying away and transporting the ſame from thence, whitherſoever they pleaſe, without any Moleſtation.

XIX.

The Kings, Princes, and States, mentioned in the following Articles, and all others who ſhall be nominated on either ſide, by common Conſent, before the Ratiſications are exchanged, or within Six Months after, ſhall, for a Mark of mutual Friendſhip, be included and comprehended in this Treaty, their Royal Majeſties aforenamed being perſuaded that they will approve all the Settlements made and eſtabliſhed by it.

XX.

Whatſoever ſhall be contained in the Treaty of Peace next entred into between his Sacred Royal Majeſty of *Spain*, and his Sacred Royal Majeſty of *Portugal*, with the previous Approbation of Her Royal Majeſty of *Great Britain*, ſhall be deemed an eſſential Part of this Treaty, in the ſame manner as if it was tranſcribed here word for word. Moreover Her Sacred Royal Majeſty of *Great Britain* offers Her ſelf to be a Surety or Guarantee of the aforeſaid Agreement of Peace, which ſhe promiſes to fulfil according to the Subſtance and Words thereof, to the end that it may be obſerved the more Sacred and Inviolable.

XXI.

The Treaty of Peace this Day entred into between his Royal Catholick Majeſty and his Royal Highneſs the Duke of *Savoy*, is ſpecially included in and confirmed by this Treaty, as an eſſential
