All persons freely pardoned for all offences, connected with the Rebellion, invacions, &c. in 1837 and 1838, and for all political offences committed before 30th January, 1817. ces of Upper and Lower-Canada, and for the Government of Canada, and it is hereby 2 enacted by the authority of the same, That all persons and parties whatsoever are and shall be acquitted, pardoned, released, discharged, indemnified and saved harmless. from all and all manner of treasons, misprisions of treason, suspicion of treason, 8 felonies, sedition or seditions, or treasonable meetings, practices, words or writings, and 10 of all riots, routs, contempts, wrongs, trespasses, misdemeanors, and other offences 12 arising out of, dependent upon or connected with the part they may have respectively 14 taken in, or with regard to the said Rebellion, troubles, disorders, invasions and acts 16 of hostile violence, and whether precedent or subsequent to the same, and generally 18 from all offences of a political nature, or against Her Majesty, Her Crown, Authority 20 and Government, committed before the thirtieth day of January, in the year of Our 22 Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fortyseven; nor shall any indictment, information, 24 or other proceeding, in any Court or Tribunal of Criminal Jurisdiction, or any suit 26 or action in any Court or Tribunal of Civil Jurisdiction, be hereafter maintained or 28 maintainable for any crime, offence or act arising out of, dependent upon or connected 30 with the part which any person or party may have taken, in or with regard to the 32 said Rebellion, troubles, disorders, invasions or acts of hostile violence, whether 34 precedent or subsequent to the same, and committed or done before the said thirtieth 36 day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven. 38

No proceeding, criminal or civil, shall be maintainable for any such offence.

Recital.

II. And whereas Her Majesty has been pleased to declare Her gracious intention to 40 remit and restore all forfeitures of lands, goods and chattels, and all penalties of a 42 pecuniary nature incurred by reason of such crimes and offences as aforesaid, except as 44 hereinafter mentioned: Be it therefore enacted, That lands and tenements, goods 46 and chattels, or sums of money, which, for
