

- Rape. *Sixthly.* Of having committed the crime of rape; or
- Abusing any infant under ten years of age. *Seventhly.* Of having unlawfully or carnally known and abused any girl under the age of ten years; or,
- Buggery. *Eighthly.* Of having been guilty of the abominable crime of buggery committed either with mankind or with any animal; or, 5
- Robbing and wounding. *Ninthly.* Of having robbed any other person, and at the time or immediately before or immediately after such robbery, stabbed, cut, or wounded any person; or,
- Burglary and assault. *Tenthly.* Of having burglariously broken and entered any dwelling house and assaulted with intent to murder any person being therein, or 10 stabbed, cut, wounded, beaten or struck any such person; or,
- Maliciously setting fire to inhabited dwelling houses. *Eleventhly.* Of having unlawfully and maliciously set fire to any dwelling house, any person being therein, or,
- Maliciously setting fire to or destroying any ship, &c. *Twelfthly.* Of having unlawfully and maliciously set fire to, cast away, or in any wise destroyed any ship or vessel, either with intent to 15 murder any person, or whereby the life of any person was endangered; or,
- Exhibiting false lights or signals. *Thirteenthly.* Of having unlawfully exhibited any false light or signal, with intent to bring any ship or vessel into danger, or of having unlawfully and maliciously done anything to cause the immediate loss or 20 destruction of any ship or vessel in distress;
- Such person shall not suffer death, nor have sentence of death awarded against him or her for the same, but shall be liable at the discretion of the Court, to be imprisoned in the Penitentiary for the term of his natural life, or for any term not less than two years, or to be 25 imprisoned in any other prison or place of confinement for any term less than two years.
