An Act to amend Chapter six of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, respecting the election of Members of the Legislature.

THEREAS it is expedient to amend Chapter six of the Consoli-Preamble. dated Statutes of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Con. Stat. of Can. cap. 6. election of Members of the Legislature": Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Conncil and Assem-5 bly of Canada, enacts as follows:
