I have been paid as Morekeeper to the 24 June last inclusive. and I would beg have to ado that I have received my allowances from the Barrack Department to the 24 Hugust, and my Nations from the Commisparied to the 24 July last. I have also received pay from the 25 the lune to the 24th December 1817, being (as it was expressed in the receipts transmitted to me for my dignature) for my gratuely. Not having been formisty officially notified as to the period when I should be Siscontinued, and unce tain how to ast, both with respect to Jay, and allowances, want as well as duty I was induced to address a letter to Capitain Peper Ass De bamp to Major Gent Widnington, of Which the analysis is a Copy; and will serve to explain why I have brown the Joay and allowances as about States.
