In reply to your letter of the 16th instant, inclosing an assignment, "William J. Smith to The Grand Trunk Pacific Branch Lines Company." covering right of way through the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 24, T. 20, R 15, W. 2 M., Pasqua reserve, I have to inform you that this assignment has been accepted and entered in the books of the Department. There is, however, a balance of purchase money and interest against the land covered by this right of way, being the proportionate amount of the unpaid balance against the quarter section. The price is \$61.54, and the interest \$12.82, or a total of \$74.26. Upon payment of this sum the question of issuing patent will receive immediate attention.
