and the other to overwhelm the arrogant Prussian spirit by all the reference that can be arrayed against it throughout the world. As a means of hastening peace and of bringing to the world the blessings of peace, the latter method will prove the only enduring one, and the individuals who desire Peace, and the nations that are solicitous of preserving it throughout the world, will do well to grasp this truth. And so we say to all who are anxious for peace, who are ready to make sacrifices for it, if it is Peace you wish do not ask us to let this vast engine of destruction be silenced only until it can be repaired, do not ask us to let this Prussian monster rest only until with renewed vitality it can destroy the better myriads of innocents still unborn, but help us now forever to rid mankind, of so unnatural a curse, that the freedom you seek may be made possible, and the peace you desire a reality and not a dream.
