Sir, With reference to that part of your report which is a reply (although irregularly so) to the Circular sent you on the 15th of September last, relative to the locating of the Indians individually upon lots within the Reserves occupied by them, I have to inform you that there can be no doubt that the Indian occupants would be benefitted by such a course being followed and it is highly desirable that they should agree to having separate locations assigned them.
