Ottawa, 22nd. May, 1909.

Sir;-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of 18th instant and in reply to transmit a somewhat altered copy of the proposed regulations re hogs and pigs running at large for adoption by the Council

As the Department is not aware that the Band has come under the provisions of the Advancement Act, the regulations will be framed under authority of Section 97, Part I of the Indian Act, and will be an amendment of those approved in 1905.

You will observe that the word Indian has been substituted for person, as a person according to the meaning of the Act is other than an Indian.

If the Council adopts the changes or corrections the Department will submit the proposed regulations to His Excellency the Governor in Council for confirmation.
