
Ottawa, 12th July 1916.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant regarding our proportion of the expense of the dyking scheme on Sea Island. Kindly submit your bill in duplicate for our portion of the cost and a separate item for maintenance to date. When this has been received the question of making payment will be further considered.

From previous correspondence, signed by W. Bridge, Reeve, it would appear that the Department is assessed for 5¹/₂ acres, (\$542.50) and annual maintenance for 1916 (\$16.90), making a total of \$559.40.
