
Ottawa, December 9th., 1916.

Sir,-

The Department has received a letter dated 5th December, making application for assistance in the way of flooring and sheathing on behalf of William Lafford. The letter, which apparently came from your office, was not signed by you. As previously pointed out the Department desires that you will personally sign all letters and vouchers which you forward to the Department. It is desired that you will at once send a letter bearing your own signature in regard to the case of William Lafford.

It is observed that you state that Dr. McKinnon has informed you that Lafford is consumptive. You should make report as to whether he is able to work and state definitely as to whether you consider that the assistance asked for should be afforded.
