asked him for my blouse, but the Sgt.
refused.

Defense having been duly sworn states:

I know the accused since two years. On the
30th of June 43 I was with him at Moore Lane
Quartermaster at Birmingham; On that day
at about 1130 hrs it was raining and cold.
When Sgt. Brode gave us order to peel po-
tatoes Cpl Baker was not with us. First
we have been provoked by the escort whom
called for us. He came in our hut and
said "Are you the three Bloody French Cans?"
he has just arrived this morning. The Sgt. called
for you." When we went outside to Sgt.
Brode he gave us order to peel potatoes.
We told him we had not ate that morning.
