turning yellow and ready for reaping. A good deal of woodland is visible on the horizon, as it has been nearly all the time; and here and there the stumps of old forest trees still stand in the fields.

Suddenly we come in sight of water, stretching away on our right, calm and blue under the zzure sky. It is Lake Erie: but it looks like the Mediterranean as I have seen it from the shores of Southern France, only instead of clive orchards we are passing acres of young peach trees. Vineyards, too, begin to make their appearance. But even here there are fields of maize, and roots, and clover, and old apple orchards.
