expenses are considerably higher and it is estimated that the present five year course cannot be done for iess than \$3,000. These are startling figures. They mean that the medical profession is no longer open to the class of young men to which reference has been made. There is another aspect of some interest. Twenty-five years ago the medical student paid for his education. All the schools were proprietary schools and none received aid from the Government of the Province. Now all are receiving annual grants from the Province of Ontarlo contributes to the cost of medical education. Will the public and the Government caimly acquiesce in this proposed increase in time and money necessary to gain an entrance to the profession of Medicine?
