At the GENERAL-ASSEMBLY of the Province of Nova-Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on the Sixth Day of June, Anno Domini 1770, in the Tenth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, &c. and there continued by several Prorogations until the Twelfth Day of October, Anno Domini 1773, in the Thirteenth Year of His faid Majesty's Reign, being the Fifth GENERAL-Assembly convened in the faid Province.

The Treasurer to take up and receive Notes defaced and worn, and to give receipts in form following.
