ROSEBERY STEPS OUT

London, June 22 - The Government was
defeated yesterday on the motion of Mr.
William St. John Broderick, Conservative
member for the Guilford division of Sur-
rey, to reduce the salary of the Secretary
of War by £100 on account of an alleged
deficiency in the army stores and munitions
of war, chiefly cordite. The motion was
adopted by a vote of 132 to 123. Pro-
gress was immediately reported.

The general belief expressed this evening
is that the defeat of the Government
means a crisis. The likelihood of the res-
ignation can be wound up in short order. The
result of the division was an unexpected

Washington, June 22 - The year old
mystery of the disappearance of the
cyclist Len, has been solved at last, as
shown by the following cablegram re-
ceived at the State Department today
from United States Minister Terrell at
Paris, the summer residence of the diplo-
matic corps near Constantinople:
"Oney, Washington: British Consul at
Ezeroun informs me that Len, the cy-
clist was murdered near Bahar by five
Turks."
