A Good Season in Scotland.

During the present shooting season it has been estimated that in all probability as many as half a million grouse and black game will be killed and sent to the market, each bird (blackcock, grouse and grouse) weighing on the average two pounds, which give as 1,000,000 pounds of food as the product (chiefly) of the vast heathlands of Scotland.
