ection with the Census are published for general information: 1. The father of a family, if aliv and present, is the proper authority o give information of his family; if he father is dead or absent, then the nother or person in charge shall

(a) Provided that any child over sixteen years of age objecting to be classed in religion by the parent may be permitted to name his or her religion to the Magistrate;

(b) That the wife, boarder or ser vant, or other person of full age present in a house, may speak for themy applying to the Court of Revision. 2. No person who has been continuously absent from Newfoundland for eighteen months immediately preceding the time of taking the Census shall be included in the Census, but this shall not be taken to exclude (1) Any child who is absent at school; and (2) Any head of a family who is employed out of the Colony, but whose family continues to reside in the Colony.

3. Every person resident in the Colony at the time the Census is being taken shall be included without reference to the length of time during which such person has resided here. In other words, the name of every actual and bona fide resident must be included.




