## "HALCYONE," by Elinor Glyn,

Author of The Reason Why, The Visits of Elizabeth, Reflections of Ambrosine, Beyond the Rocks, His Hour, etc. Paper, 50c. Cloth, 75c.

Much of the action of Mrs. Glyn's new novel takes place in a beautiful park in England. The story opens when the heroine, a lively child of twelve, is living with her two great aunts in the old castle. One day Halcyone sees smoke coming out of the little house that had been the land steward's, creeps through the park paling and finds an old Oxford school at there. They make friends, and during the following summer he teaches her Greek and mythology, and talks with her in such a way that he really gives her an education. She has found in the castle the broken bust of a goddess, who seems to her to represent love, and this goddess plays an important part all through her life. When she is about fifteen she meets John Derringham, handsome, splendid, but supremely selfish. Meanwhile Halcyone is developing into a finished product of Greek life and thought. To Halcyone Derringham represents Jason, Perseus and all the other Greek heroes, and quite unknowingly she falls in love with him. The day is her Derringham's kingdom, the night is hers. He plans to run off with her and marry her secretly. On the way to the trust he breaks his ankle, and soon after she is carried off to Europe by her old friend, the professor. Derringham is nursed back to life by a rich widow, who becomes engaged to him, but who subsequently throws him over when she finds that he is going to be lame. Derringham hastens to Greece, catches Halcyone in the temple of her goddess, and after another beautiful scene all ends well.


