ENGLAND.

London, May 12.—In the house of commons this afternoon Sir Edward Watkin, liberal member for Hythe, moved the second reading of the channel tunnel bill Right Hon. Jos. Chamberlain, on behalf of the board of trade of which he is president, opposed the measure and stated that the government as a whole are opposed to further progress of the bill. The opposition cheered this declaration and the bill was then rejected by a vote of 281 to 99.
