3. That the Mission of our "hurch to the Jews, both in Palestine and our own land be borne on all hearts in fervent prayer.

Thus our beloved Church will be saved from bringin couragement and sorrow on cur Missions and Mission Workers. Our Church has done much in the past. We believe she can and will do this which is so urgently required of her.
