It is rumored that a company will publish "The Youth's Magazine" here in this city, and one of the departments that will appeal to collectors is that devoted to stamps. Canada has no paper of this class, save those issued by religious houses for Sunday School purposes.

THE STAMPS OF BULGARIA.

The latest issue, the notorious Baby Boris series, consists of four values, 18 dark green, 5s dark blue, 15s mauve and 25s red. Design: Coat of arms in center; above inscription on rounded band; at top, another inscription on dark ground; at bottom, in center, figure of value in circle; ribbons on each side with Russian characters thereon.

Three values of unpaid letter stamps have been issued from 1894 to date. Design: Figure of value in center in circle, surrounded by Russian inscription; inscription also at sides and at top and bottom ruled off; open space filled by pearls and branches of leaves. The values are, 5s orange, 25s crimson and 50s blue.

These appeared with large wavy perforations in 1884, imperforate in 1886, and perforated 101 and 111 in

In 1894 the 5s orange appeared reengraved, differing but very little from first issue. It is also to be found on pelure paper.

The 50s blue was surcharged "30" in 1895. This surcharge will be found on both imperforate and perforated 111 issues.

The 25s re-engraved, perforated 11, made its appearance a few months ago.

Having considered its postal emissions let us take a glance at the history of the country.

The Romans were unable to conquer the original inhabitants of the present Bulgaria, and the Grecian emperor, Anastasius, built a large wall in A.D. 507, in order to keep them out of his domains.

In the seventh century the Bulgarian, a people of Tartar origin, conquered, the country and founded the Bulgarian kingdom. The conquerors soon lost their language and customs and adopted those of the Slavs they subjugated.

The Bulgarian kings were continually taking part in the struggles between the Greeian emperors and the Russian chiefs, sometimes on one side sometimes on the other. In 1018 the monarchy was under the suzerainty of the Byzantino empire. I 1185 King Asan declared the country independent of Constantinople, which resulted hadly for it, as the kings of Hungary (To be Conclude I in next issue)
