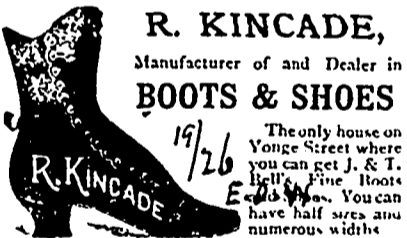

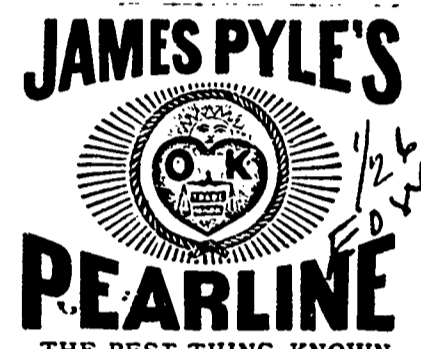

Scientific and Useful.

A "GRAN" of fresh peach leaves boiled for a minute or two in the milk you are going to make into custard will give it a delightful almond flavour.

ROLLS.—Grate two cold potatoes at night, add some salt, a little sugar, a little hot water to slightly warm the potatoes. Then add half a teacup of yeast, shaking it well first. In the morning put a small piece of lard in a frying pan, and pour in a pint of milk. When it is warm then add the yeast: make it into a sponge; when light make it only moderately stiff with flour; let it rise again, well out, and cut into round cakes; fold one side partly over the other, greasing between with butter melted, and when light again bake for twenty minutes.

CREAM PIE.—The yolks of two eggs, two-thirds of a cup of sugar, one-half cup flour and one pint sweet milk. Mix the eggs, flour and sugar thoroughly, and stir into the milk when it boils; flavour with lemon. Bake a pie crust, pour the mixture into it, and place it in the oven for fifteen minutes. Beat the whites of the eggs thoroughly, and mix with two tablespoonfuls of sugar; place it over the top of the pie, and set in a hot oven till lightly browned.

SPONGE GINGER BREAD.—In two cups of molasses sift two teaspoonfuls of soda and a desertspoonful of ginger and one of powdered cinnamon. Stir to a cream; then add four well-beaten eggs, one-half cup of butter and one-half cup of lard, melted; one cup of sour milk in which is dissolved three-quarters of a teaspoonful of soda. Mix all together; then add flour to the consistency of pound cake; two teacupfuls of raisins or English currants are a great improvement. Chop the raisins.

RAGOUT OF MUTTON.—Cold roasted mutton is cut, as evenly as possible, into strips of about one-half inch long and one-quarter inch wide, leaving out all the fat. Then, in a frying-pan, brown in butter a teaspoonful to a tablespoonful of flour (according to the quantity of gravy desired) to a chestnut colour, carefully stirring all the time to avoid its burning in spots. Then add slowly the gravy left over from the roast, add water, if the quantity is not sufficient, and bring to a boil until it becomes a smooth creamy sauce; add salt, pepper and celery—salt to taste; place the meat into it, cover tightly, and let it simmer from five to ten minutes on the back of the range or stove. It should be served very hot, plain or on toast. This is a very good and inexpensive dish for breakfast or luncheon.

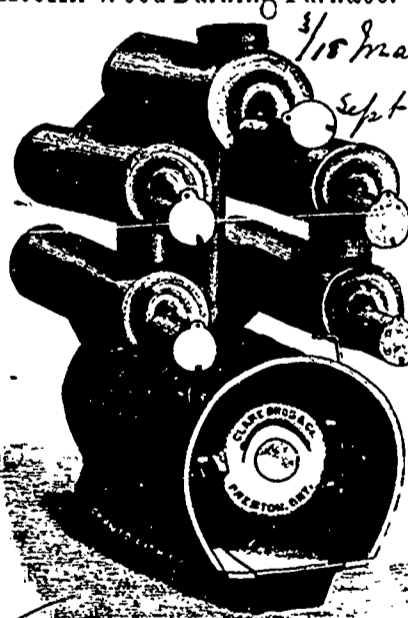
